<u>The Potential Catchment Area</u> for membership is initially the **County of Simcoe** and the **Regional Municipality of Muskoka**.

<u>CAHS Membership Base Potential</u> is high given the percentage of military and retirees, which in turn would give a strong resource for the formation of a Chapter Executive (President / VPs / Directors / Volunteers).

<u>Potential Corporate Members</u> could include Canadian Forces Units / Canadian Legions / Air Force Associations / Georgian College-Aviation Program / Barnstormer Brewery -Barrie, etc
